

NEW FOUR-BOLT FLOOR FLANGES


Affected Models: All Traveler® toilets.

New Product information: The Traveler toilet requires a four-bolt style floor flange. In the past, four-bolt flanges were only available in a limited number of configurations (such as 3" MPT but not 3" socket). Not all four-bolt flanges have been listed by both IAPMO (UPC), the U.S. plumbing approval authority, and Canadian Standards Association (CSA), the Canadian approval authority. SeaLand has developed a new heavy-duty four-bolt flange available in both 3" MPT and 3" socket configurations. Both configurations have been accepted by UPC and CSA.


An important feature of SeaLand's new flange is an indexing system to make proper alignment for all gravity discharge toilets a simple operation. The flange is marked with three arrows. Each arrow represents the correct bolt alignment for a different toilet mounting system. Please refer to the following illustrations.



Position 1 is for use with SeaLand toilets.



Position 2 is for two bolt toilets with a 3 o'clock & 9 o'clock Such alignment. Thetford AquaMagic IV, Sanitation Equipment Perma Flush and Valterra LeToilete.



Position 3 is for two bolt units such as AquaMagic Galaxy or Starlite.
