

# Is the LP-1000 Right for You? ... Some things to consider!

Winegard Company wants its customers to be confident and satisfied with their satellite TV antenna purchases. While the RoadTrip™ LP-1000 is a dependable and reliable in-motion system, Winegard would like to offer some things to consider in order to help you determine if the LP-1000 is right for you.

## Things to consider:

**The LP-1000 is a single receiver compatible system.** If you require dual receiver compatibility, we recommend our MV3500T In-motion, dual receiver compatible system.

**If you have height restrictions, the LP-1000 provides a low profile height of only 6".**

If you don't have a height restriction, the following models are recommended:

MV3500A – 15" Stationary domed, dual receiver compatible

MV3500T – 15" In-motion domed, dual receiver compatible

**With a lower profile system there is less signal strength,** which may cause you to lose signal depending on your location in the US. (See coverage maps. Light gray areas indicate reception areas).



**The system performs best while it is used in-motion.** If you will be viewing your TV primarily while you are parked, the LP-1000 may not be the best choice.

**The LP-1000 is not recommended for high precipitation areas.** The flat dome allows for moisture (dew, rain, snow, etc.) to rest on the dome, causing signal loss to occur. Driving often resolves this problem. ProtectAll polish is a product and is recommended as a topical treatment to help bead up the moisture and assist it to fall off the dome easier. Another option would be to get an RV extension broom so that you could wipe off any standing moisture from the dome.

**The LP-1000 is right for you if you have a height restriction,  
plan to use it In-motion or are in a low precipitation area.**
