Product affected: TracVision R6DX and R6 (serial numbers 080401467 or earlier)

Problem Description

TracVision[®] R6DX and original R6 owners might experience difficulties tracking the 110°W satellite due to an unannounced change to that satellite's configuration (the FEC code has changed from 5/6 to 7/8). When the DISH Network[®] or DIRECTV[®] satellite at 110°W is selected, the TracVision system either won't find the satellite or will lose track after changing channels.

Problem Solution

All TracVision R6DX/R6 systems built after the serial numbers listed above contain RF software (revision D) that automatically determines the FEC code. *No updates are necessary for these systems*.

Systems having an older revision of RF software installed (serial numbers prior to those listed above) need to be updated for this satellite configuration change. To do this, manually update the FEC code or update the system's software using the latest version of the KVH Flash Update Wizard on the <u>KVH Partner Portal</u>.

Complete details on the the changes to the 110°W satellite configuration and instructions for updating the FEC code are available in a new technical bulletin on the <u>KVH Partner Portal</u>.
